Campbellsville Fire – Rescue is a progressive combination fire – rescue department that provides emergency services to the citizens and visitors of Campbellsville and Taylor County. These services include fire suppression, hazardous materials, and numerous aspects of rescue including vehicle extrication, water, dive, rope, trench, and confined space. The department also assists Campbellsville/Taylor County EMS on emergency medical calls and works closely with the Taylor County Fire Department through an automatic aid agreement.

#### **CAMPBELLSVILLE CITY LIMITS**

Campbellsville Fire-Rescue is responsible for fire suppression, hazardous materials response, vehicle accidents, EMS assist and technical rescue services.

#### **TAYLOR COUNTY**

Campbellsville Fire-Rescue is responsible for hazardous materials responses, vehicle accidents, EMS assist and technical rescue services through 3 separate agreements including Campbellsville/Taylor County Interlocal Agreement, Campbellsville Taylor County Emergency Medical Services Extrication/Rescue Services Contract and Taylor County Emergency Management Affiliation Agreement.


2021 has been the busiest year on record. This year has had plenty of challenges as well. I have witnessed some of the more serious incidents of my ca-

reer in 2021. Particularly the past 3 months. However, our team has performed well and has absolutely saved several lives and property.


