## **CAMPBELLSVILLE CITY LIMITS-FULL JURISDICTION**





Campbellsville Fire-Rescue is responsible for fire suppression, hazardous materials response, vehicle accidents, EMS assist and technical rescue services. We protect a population of 11, 820 inside the city limits over 6.1 square miles. We also work with the Kentucky State Fire Marshalls office for all inspection types. We estimate we protect around 18,000 – 22,000 people (residents, students, employees and visitors) on a daily basis.


## **TAYLOR COUNTY -RESCUE RESPONSIBILITIES**

Campbellsville Fire-Rescue is responsible for hazardous materials responses, vehicle accidents, EMS assist and technical rescue services through 3 separate agreements including Campbellsville/Taylor County Interlocal Agreement, Campbellsville Taylor County Emergency Medical Services Extrication/Rescue Services Contract and Taylor County Emergency Management Affiliation Agreement. We serve the population of 26,809 people over 277 square miles for rescue services. Including 8,200 acre Green River Lake and 21,019 acres of wildlife management
